Tracey Jessen intends to use the scholarship to pursue The International Diploma in Botanic Garden Education, developed jointly by the Royal Botanic Gardens, Kew and Botanic Gardens

Conservation International in the spring of 2014. Upon completion of the five-week training, Tracey will enhance and diversify the events and educational offerings at the Halifax Public Gardens in Nova Scotia, Canada.

The Chanticleer Scholarship promotes creativity and leadership by providing professional development opportunities for public garden staff. It has two core components; academic study to improve leadership skills and support of travel to meet with leaders to build on that academic experience. Each Scholar has the opportunity to visit

other gardens, including Chanticleer, a 35-acre pleasure garden in Wayne, PA. The next scholarship application deadlines are July 1 and November 1, 2014.
